## TEXAS AVIATION HALL OF FAME

Established in 1995, the Texas Aviation Hall of Fame honors the men and woman of Texas who have shaped the aviation world. These inductees are famous aviators from Texas who have made extraordinary contributions to aviation, or a Texas aviator who has made an extraordinary contribution in another field.

## FLIGHT ACADEMY

The Flight Academy introduces visitors to the foundations of flight and aircraft design with hands-on exhibits including three replica cockpits, two hang glider simulators and a theater featuring a film about the principles and history of flight development.

Two 30,000 square foot hangars house more than 20 beautifully restored aircraft including: Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress, North American B-25 Mitchell, Republic P-47 Thunderbolt, Chance Vought F4U Corsair, Douglas SBD Dauntless and Douglas DC-3. Each aircraft has an information station with fascinating details and specifications. Be sure to converse with one of our docents along the way as they can provide you with more history and facts. Visiting aircraft are always changing so keep coming back to see what's new.

## AVIATION LEARNING CENTER

#12 on the Map

The Aviation Learning Center (ALC) is an innovative facility that immerses visitors in the energy and excitement of flight through a hands-on learning experience. Designed for students in grades 5-12, participants get a taste of aviation training, preflight a Mooney aircraft, and pilot a simulated flight! When not reserved by schools, the ALC is available for museum visitors and private events. (Additional entry fee required.)


### SUPPORT
